ranks 198 in the world in latest university rankings

London, 27th June: Universidad de los Andes has been named as one of the world's top universities, according to the twentieth edition of the world's most-consulted university rankings.

The 2024 edition of the QS World University Rankings, released today by global higher education analyst QS Quacquarelli Symonds, see Universidad de los Andes place #198 in the world and #1 in Colombia.

In celebration of the twentieth anniversary of the ranking and to reflect the growth in data availability and changing priorities of students and society at large over the past two decades, QS has implemented the largest methodological enhancement since its inception, introducing three new metrics: Sustainability, Employment Outcomes and International Research Network, and adjusting the weighting of some existing indicators, namely Academic Reputation, Employer Reputation, and Faculty Student Ratio. Overview: QS World University Rankings 2023

This year's QS World University Rankings is the largest ever, with 1,500 universities across 104 locations, up from 1418 last year. The results account for the distribution and performance of 17.5 million academic papers published between 2017 and 2021 and the 141.6 million citations received by those papers; they also account for the expert opinions of over 144,000 academic faculty and over 98,000 employers around the world.

Global Highlights

- 75% of Africa's universities improve. Nine entries rank for the first time.
- Arab Region remains increasingly competitive.
- Asia's top university, National University of Singapore (8th) breaks into top-10. South Korea and Japan remain strong but less prolific. Thailand and Indonesia emerging.
- Australian internationalisation agenda shines. Three universities join the top-20.
- Canada: University of Toronto is the new national leader.
- China: Most improved for research impact (79% institutions rise in Citations per Faculty).
- ETH Zurich is continental Europe's best university for the sixteenth consecutive year.
- France's merged universities continue success. Université PSL (24th) enters the top-25.
- India: New national leader, IIT Bombay, climbs into world top-150.
- Universidade de São Paulo (85th) takes Latin America's top-spot.
- UK remains intensely collaborative in terms of cross-border research collaboration.
- USA: UC Berkeley, named world's leader in Sustainability, breaks into top-10.
